As a result of my immediate care the player was effectively transferred to the hospital and later underwent surgery that evening. I received appraisal from the general practitioner that my careful attention to the player prevented the injury from worsening. Post surgery the player was dissatisfied with the level of physiotherapy he was receiving and is now attending my sports injury clinic on a weekly basis in his return to full fitness.
